

Instructions for the public

Tropical Cyclone Alert Level 1

- If you are at a considerable distance from your home, choose to stay somewhere safe nearby or in the emergency shelter provided by local authorities.
- Take down any aerial installations, scaffolding, etc.
- Immediately put all construction cranes in their safety positions.
- Close your shutters over windows and other openings or, if you do not have shutters, board them up.
- Halt all professional, school or business activities two hours before the estimated start of Tropical Cyclone Alert Level 2.
- Stop all nautical activities.
- If your home is not solidly built or if it is located in an area at risk from storm surge or flooding, go to the emergency shelter provided by local authorities, inform neighbors or family that you are in the shelter, and then stay there.
- If you have a rainwater tank, disconnect its filling system.
- Make sure your pets and farm animals are in a safe place.
- Put tape across all bay windows and glass doors.
- Put personal documents (identity papers, vaccination records, blood group cards) in a safe place, out of the reach of water.
