

## Instructions for the public Safeguard Phase

- Stay informed of the conditions of public utility networks and roads.
- Keep all travel to the strict minimum.
- Carefully comply with bans on swimming and other nautical activities.
- Do not touch any electrical wires on the ground or roads.
- Beware of falling objects and landslides.
- Do not use your phone unless absolutely necessary to avoid overloading the system.
- Report any injuries or casualties to first-aid and rescue services.
- Actively participate in relief efforts when you are requested to do so by a competent authority.
- Never drive or walk into a submerged road or pathway.
- Check the state of all food items before eating.
- Do not drink any water from water tanks or the public water system until confirmation that is safe to drink.
- In case of an emergency when no bottled water is available, boil the water for 10 minutes and drink it after it has cooled down.
- Gather all dead animals in a single outdoor area and contact the competent services to collect them.
- Repair and shore up your house, if necessary.
